Storage of Lantal products

Recommended storage conditions

In the interest of problem-free processability of the following Lantal products delivered as yardage

- flat weave and velvet fabrics
- leathers/sheep skins
- carpets
- dado panels
- TEC-Leather

we recommend compliance with these storage conditions:



Ideal temperature:
Storage room with 18 - 23°C temperature



Ideal relative humidity:
Air humidity of 50% to 60% with low air fluctuation.



No exposure to direct sunlight or ceiling light



Packed in plastic – one side opened to prevent condensation

- ✓ We recommend storage on tubular frames or on shelves in original packaging. Store rolls horizontally in pyramid fashion, but not more than two rolls high to avoid pressure marks.
- ✓ If possible hang leather hides over a tubular frame. Otherwise, store in small stacks laid out flat on wooden pallets. Hides can also remain rolled in their boxes
- ✓ Only carpet rolls up to 200 cm width can be stored upright (on wooden pallets).
- ✓ Never store directly on floor, along walls, or in front of heaters or other heat sources.
- ✓ Carpets should be unrolled and laid flat on the floor at least one day before cutting.
- ✓ Boxed leather hides should be unrolled and laid flat on a table or hung over a frame at least one day before cutting.
- ✓ Do not remove packaging until just prior to processing.

Shelf life of Lantal products

For textiles, carpets and TEC-Leather, Lantal guarantees a maximum shelf life of one year from the delivery date on. The maximum storage period for leathers should not exceed 6 months provided that the Lantal products are stored in accordance with the above conditions. For carpets with self-adhesive coating, Lantal guarantees full adhesion for 18 months after the production date.

Complaints

Complaints, if any, must be submitted to Lantal within five days after delivery of the goods. Once the products have been processed and cut, Lantal can no longer accept complaints.
