

## Ready-to-install products Literature pockets



### Key advantages

Lantal's ready-to-install literature pockets have the following compelling advantages:

### Specification

#### Composition

The netting of the literature pocket is made of 100% polyester. The pocket frame is covered with a flat-weave fabric or leather.

#### Designs and colors

Lantal's literature pockets are produced to customer specifications as regards shape and material. The color, mesh aperture and structure, as well as the

material thickness of the nets can be individually selected. The shape, size, and cover material of the frame into which the net is tensioned can be freely selected as well. Please ask Lantal for counsel and customized design options.

#### Development and handling

Lantal cooperates with the customer in the development of the literature pockets. Acceptance prototypes are submitted before commercial production begins. The finished literature pockets are shipped to the seat manufacturer in a ready-to-install state.

#### Weight

The conditioned weight of a literature pocket is approximately 84 g (2.9 oz), depending on the net and the frame covering (leather, fabric).

#### Lightfastness

Lantal's literature pockets are lightfast and fulfill all airworthiness requirements.

#### Flammability, smoke/toxicity

Lantal's literature pockets are made of materials permanently flame-resistant in accordance with FAR/CS 25.853 Appendix F Part I (a)(1)(II) and (a)(1)(IV), and meet the Airbus and Boeing specifications for smoke and toxicity where applicable.

#### Service lifetime

The specific service lifetime depends largely on the airline's interior philosophy (colors, quality), routing (long-haul, short-haul and charter flights), geographical routes, load factors, and cleaning attitudes.
