Steam pleated & sewn pleated curtains Comparison after washing and dry cleaning

Introduction

Pleated curtains not only offer functionality as class dividers, they are also attractive components that accent the overall appearance of the aircraft cabin. Lantal conducted washing and dry cleaning tests with steam pleated and sewn pleated curtains for performance comparison purposes.

Advantages of steam pleated curtains versus sewn pleated curtains

- Permanent pleats assure a perfect look across the curtain's lifetime
- Pleats always retain their same good shape even after numerous cleaning cycles
- No pleat distortion due to yarn contraction, the pleats remain straight and uniform, even when tied back
- Easy to maintain, no additional ironing needed after cleaning

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Lantal recommends steam pleated curtains for all of the above-mentioned reasons.
