Origin

The sheepskins are sourced mainly from Switzerland.

The conditioned weight is approx. 1000 g/m², 29.5 oz/sy

Skin size

Approx. 0.8 m²

Thickness

16-20 mm, 0.63-0.79 in

Area of equal color

Lengthwise: 75-80 cm, 29.5-31.5 in
Crosswise: 45-50 cm, 17.5-19.5 in

Fur surface

Straight to curly, mast pleats possible
Deformity of pile direction possible

Absorption of perspiration

Excellent, provides enhanced seating comfort for the pilot's well-being. Moisture is absorbed, buffered, and released again.

Specification

Flammability, smoke/toxicity

Lantal sheepskins are permanently flame-resistant in accordance with FAR/CS 25.853, 12 sec. vertical, if cleaned according to Lantal cleaning recommendations.

Cleaning

If heavily soiled, they can be washed at max. 30°C or dry-cleaned as per Lantal cleaning recommendations.

Service lifetime

Approx. 4 to 5 years

The specific service lifetime depends largely on routing (long-haul, short-haul), geographical routes, load factors and cleaning attitudes.
