Key advantages

Lantal wool standard carpets have the following compelling advantages:

Recommended application

Lantal produces wool standard carpets with weights ranging from 1500 to 1960 g/m2, including types that are particularly suitable for shorthaul service on any aircraft.

Properties

Composition

Wilton-woven, loop pile, some also float-woven, 2 or 3-ply twisted yarn, 100% new virgin wool, conductivity-treated.

Backing

Synthetic and glass fiber back weave, latex back coating.

Designs and colors

The Lantal product line covers a selection of predefined designs and colors.

A choice of classic colors is available off the shelf. On request, customized designs and colors can be developed.

Weight

The conditioned weight varies from 1500 to 1960 g/m² / 44 to 58 oz/sy, tolerance ±5%.

Width

200/252 cm, 79/99 in

Dimensional stability

Within 0.5% shrinkage when wet cleaned by spray extraction according to Lantal cleaning recommendations.

Specification

Flammability, smoke/toxicity

Lantal carpets are permanently flame-resistant in accordance with FAR/CS 25.853, 12 sec. vertical, and meet the Airbus and Boeing specifications for smoke and toxicity if cleaned according to Lantal cleaning recommendations.

Cleaning

By spray extraction at max. 40°C (104°F) as per Lantal cleaning recommendations.

Service lifetime

Aisles approx. 4 to 8 months
Under seats approx. 8 to 18 months

(colors, quality), routing (long-haul, short-haul), geographical routes, load factors and cleaning attitudes.
